

IT Asset Disposition for a Pennsylvania Apple Distinguished School District

Seamlessly retiring Apple devices while funding the district's 1:1 technology initiative.



Quantity = 1,572

Logistics included the packaging materials and shipment of thousands of data-bearing assets at no cost to the school district.

Value = \$210k

The final value paid to the district was determined by the functional and cosmetic condition of the IT assets.

Weight = 2.75 tn

Secure Process

Traceability for every asset with complete visibility, resulted in zero data breaches or compliance issues.

Overview

A Pennsylvania Apple Distinguished school district, with over 1,500 MacBooks and iPads required a secure IT asset disposition (ITAD) solution. As part of its spring technology refresh, the district planned to upgrade devices before the end of the school year.

Challenge

The district needed a solution to manage large-scale equipment removal across multiple schools with minimal disruption to students and staff. Security and compliance were essential, requiring certified data erasure, asset tag removal, and clear audit reporting. The district sought to maximize recovery value from retired Apple devices to reinvest in 1:1 technology initiatives.

Results

PowerON delivered complete "white glove" service by deploying an on-site logistics team to securely package and load devices for shipment. Once received at PowerON's facility, each device was tracked throughout the process. Devices were securely wiped, asset tags removed, audited for condition, and prepared for resale. The district received detailed reports confirming secure erasure, audit results, and recovery value. All funds were reinvested into the 1:1 technology initiative, directly benefiting students.
